ONCE I BREATHED THE HONEY ROSE FIFTEEN ETCHINGS

To Dov With love and longing In her etchings of black and gold Khen Shish tells the story of the ancient and holy city of Safed, shrouded in secrecy. It is the Safed where Rabbi Yosef Caro conceived and wrote the Shulchan Arukh (Code of Laws); the Safed where the grave of the holy Ha'ari (the Kabbalist Rabbi Yitzhak Luria) is found, and where other rabbis, scholars and teachers of Judaism from every ethnic origin and diaspora are buried; and the Safed that is the source of tales and legends lovingly recorded by the writer Yehoshua Bar-Yosef.

Khen's black is not simply a basic color. It is as dark and deep as the pupils of the eyes of many Galilee women. Her gold is not a jeweled decoration. It is a color that begins with the rise of the sun in the mountains of Judea and Jerusalem, grows brighter and stronger, lighting the earth in its entirety, fields and cities, until at sunset it sinks into the depths of the Mediterranean from Rosh Hanikra until the Gaza shore. And as it passes over Safed and Mount Meron it adorns itself and draws in the curls of the little children in all their shades, from black to gold.

Khen has given us grandeur, and Ofra, Sharon and Ravit have worked wonders with their talent and knowledge. They are a credit to the workshop and to us.
